


What's Changing?



Improves service frequency by operating every 15 minutes from 7 AM to 7 PM on weekdays and every 30 minutes from 8 AM to 6 PM on Saturdays.





What's Changing?



Terminates at Valley Central Shopping Mall instead of Sgt. Steve Owen Memorial Park. The new route also removes the segment that extends east of 30th St E due to very low passenger activity. However, temporary route deviations beyond 30th St may occur for special events (such as job fairs).







What's Changing?




Provides faster and more direct service along Avenue J (a corridor with high ridership) by removing detour to Valley Central Shopping Mall. Valley Central is now served by Route 11.



What's Changing?



New service connects Sgt. Steve Owen Memorial Park, Lancaster Metrolink Station and heath care centers via 15th Street W (similar to the existing Route 11).




Improves access to Antelope Valley Hospital, Kaiser Permanente AV and serves new destinations along 15th Street W.



Improves service frequency by operating every 50 minutes from 6 AM to 8 PM on weekdays and on weekends.



Removes service on Avenue travels to Lancaster Metrolink Station via Sierra Highway to reduce service duplication and to simplify the network.







Terminates at Lancaster Metrolink Station and removes service on Sierra Highway, which is now served by Route 7.







Late Night Service

What's Changing?



Residents have expressed an interest in expanding transit service hours later into the evenings, but the low-density land use across the Antelope Valley means that fixed-route transit is not cost-effective during evenings when transit demand is low.

The proposed late night service will operate as an on-request service where riders can book trips using a smartphone app or by telephone. Depending on the trip, most riders will be picked up at existing AVTA bus stops or at a street corner and dropped off at a bus stop or transfer center. Transfer centers will be located in Lancaster and Palmdale, where riders can then transfer to routes 1, 11 and 12 that operate later into the evening than other fixed routes.


This change will take place starting in September 2020 (Phase 1). See the project website and FAQ tab for more details.



The three frequent transit routes (1, 11 and 12) are proposed to operate until 12 AM on weekdays. All other routes will operate as on-request service starting at 9 PM on weekdays, 8 PM on Saturdays and 7 PM on Sundays. On-request service will run until 1 AM on all local routes, seven days of the week.

What's Changing?



Terminates at North Hollywood Metro Station, where riders can connect to the subway for quick service to Downtown LA. This change is expected to create shorter and more reliable travel times.




Consolidates service into fewer trips. The eighth and ninth trip in each direction will be removed due to low ridership. Trips will depart from 4 AM to 6 AM and from 3 PM to 6 PM.





What's Changing?



Terminates at Wilshire Blvd and Santa Monica Blvd, where passengers traveling farther east can transfer to LA Metro 20 or 720, which provides rapid service through dedicated bus-only lanes along Wilshire Blvd.




Consolidates service into fewer trips. The fifth trip in each direction will be removed due to low ridership.



Offers new connections to LA Metro lines 20, 720, 4, 16, 316, and 704, and future LA Purple Line Extension (expected completion in 2027).

Terminates at Warner Center due to low ridership beyond this point.






